<u>Timeline (1): Rosebery Park Baptist Church and Pokesdown.</u>

- 1867 Pokesdown is a thriving village, Boscombe is a nearby hamlet.
- 1871 Pokesdown population 511.
- 1874 Boscombe Baptist Church established.
- 1876 Freemantle Estate built.
- 1877 Boscombe, Pokesdown & Springbourne Infirmary opened.
- 1881 Pokesdown population 1,231.
- 1886 Railway station opened at Pokesdown, but called "Boscombe Station".
- 1886 horse-drawn omnibus route extended to Pokesdown.
- 1887 Rosebery Park Estate built.
- 1887 Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee.
- 1888 first electricity in Bournemouth.
- 1889 Freemantle Baptist Mission Chapel opened.
- 1891 Pokesdown population 3,033.
- 1891 Rosebery Park Baptist Church formed, with 24 members meeting in a rented room.
- 1892 Rosebery Park Baptist Chapel built.
- 1894 to 1895 Lord Rosebery is Prime Minister.
- 1895 to 1901 Pokesdown is an Urban District Council.
- 1897 Boscombe Station opens on Ashley Road. Original Boscombe Station renamed Pokesdown.
- 1897 Rosebery Park Baptist Chapel expanded.
- 1898 Pokesdown Science, Art & Technical School built, 896 Christchurch Road, Pokesdown.
- 1898 Pokesdown population 4,927.
