1901 Death of Queen Victoria.

1901 Pokesdown population 4,930.

1901 Pokesdown made a part of Bournemouth.

1902 tramway opens Lansdowne to Pokesdown.

1902 Coronation Edward VII.

1905 Pokesdown tram depot opened.

1911 Coronation King George V.

1913 Pokesdown Fire Station built.

1913 ornamental Fisherman's Walk opened.

1914 to 1918 First World War.

c.1917/early 1920s name of Freemantle has dropped out of general use.

1926 Rosebery Park Baptist Church has 126 members.

1931 Keswick Hall built on Christchurch Road, Pokesdown.

early 1930s suggestion Rosebery Park Baptists change their name to Pokesdown Baptists is rejected.

1934-36 trolleybuses replace trams in Bournemouth.

1937 Coronation of King George VI.

1939 to 1945 Second World War.

1948 National Health Service established.

1949 Rosebery Park Baptist Church has 252 members.

1951 (October) Rosebery Park Baptist Church moves into Keswick Hall (our current venue).

1951 Festival of Britain.

1953 Rosebery Park Baptist Church has 317 members.

1953 Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II.
